South African artist Christiaan Pretorius painted a swirling pattern on the underside of the 24-inch-diameter glass top, which stands 26 inches high on a hand-forged steel base with aluminum-leaf finish.

The **Flac** coffee table's organic nature brings to mind a trio of mushrooms sprouting in the forest. Hubert Le Gall specified lacquered bronze in a mottled gray finish for the low and wide model, which measures a generous 53 by 49 inches but a mere 15 1/4 inches high. 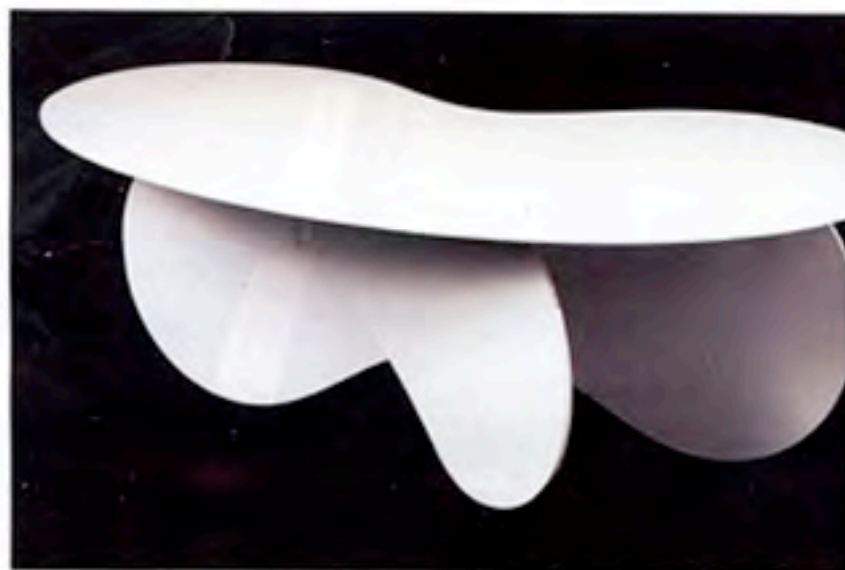

The elliptical tracks where gold-medal hopefuls go through their paces supplied both the name and the silhouette of the **Olimpo** coffee table. Black-lacquered carbon steel and açaí wood form the frame—59 inches wide, 36 1/2 inches deep, and 16 1/4 inches high—that supports an oval crystal top. 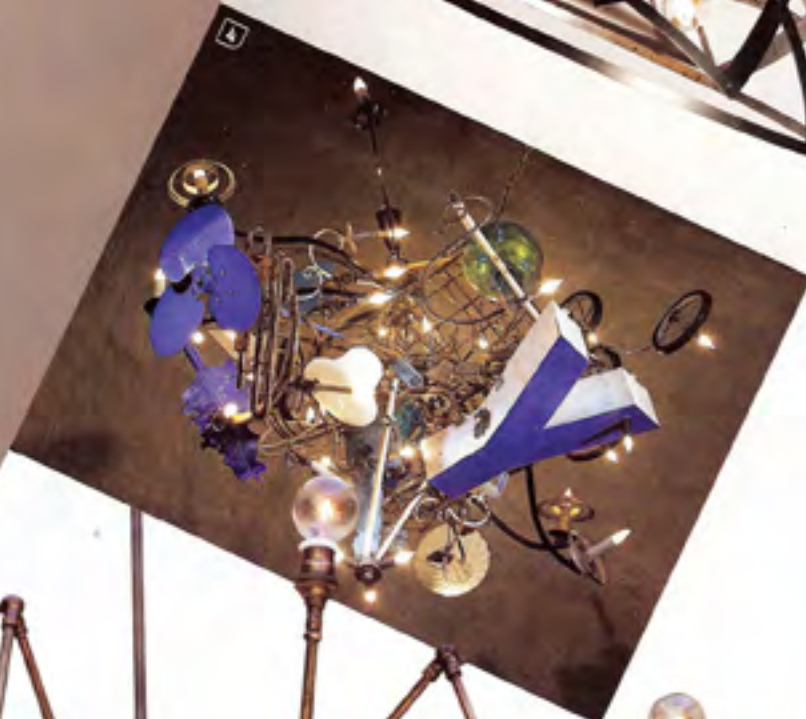

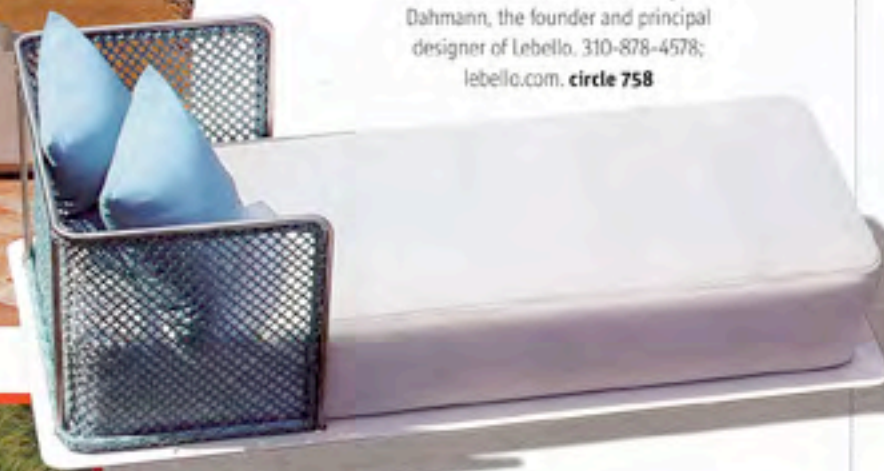
